Roles & Responsibilities

- To comply with the directions of the Hon. Supreme Court as well as regulations of UGC and be vigilant on the acts amounting to ragging.
- To take all necessary measures for prevention of ragging inside the campus.
- To publicize to all students about prevalent directives and the actions that can be taken against those indulging in ragging.
- To consider the complaints received from the students and conduct enquiry and submit report to the Principal along with punishment recommended for the offenders.
- To provide students the information pertaining to contact numbers of the Anti-Ragging Helpline as well as functionaries of the college.
- To offer services of counselling and create awareness to the students.

Ingredients/forms of Ragging	Punishments
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Abetment to ragging; • Criminal conspiracy to rag; • Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging; • Public nuisance created during ragging; • Violation of decency and morals through ragging; • Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt; • Wrongful restraint; • Wrongful confinement; • Use of criminal force; • Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural offences; • Extortion; • Criminal trespass; • Offences against property; • Criminal intimidation; • Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offences against the victim(s); • Physical or psychological humiliation; • All other offences following from the definition of “Ragging”. 	<p>Cancellation of admission, Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges, withdrawing scholarship and other benefits, Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process, various tournaments, youth festival etc.</p>

In compliance of the 3rd Amendment in UGC Regulations on 29th June, 2016 to expand the definition of ragging by including the following:

"Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background".
