Dr. Sandeep Kumar, the Chairperson, commenced the meeting by extending a warm welcome to all members of the IQAC. The proceedings of the previous meeting, held on 31/05/2024, were read by the Chairperson. Following this, discussions began on the agenda previously shared with the members.

Item No. 1: To implement the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 for undergraduate programs.

Panjab University is going to implement NEP-2020 across all its affiliated colleges starting from the 2024-25 academic session.



During the meeting, the Chairperson apprised the members about the college's preparedness to adopt the policy. He provided a detailed overview of the measures taken by the institution to ensure a smooth transition, including curriculum restructuring, faculty training, and infrastructure upgrades to align with the principles and guidelines of NEP-2020.

The Chairperson also highlighted the challenges associated with implementing the policy at the college level, such as potential gaps in faculty orientation, limited resources, and the need for additional infrastructure to support multidisciplinary and skill-based education. A productive and insightful discussion followed, during which members shared several innovative and practical solutions to address these hurdles. Suggestions included enhanced collaboration with the university for training programs, leveraging technology to deliver skill-based courses, and forming committees to monitor and evaluate the implementation process effectively.


The collective input provided during the discussion was highly valuable and will play a crucial role in ensuring the successful implementation of NEP-2020 at the college. The Chairperson expressed gratitude for the members' active participation and their commitment to the advancement of the institution under the framework of the new education policy.

Item No. 2: Discussion on the academic and activity calendar for the session 2024-25

A draft calendar for the 2024-25 academic year, including both academic and extra-curricular activities, was presented. The proposed schedule highlighted key events such as house exams, short-term value-added Courses, guest lectures, business plan competitions, job fair, industrial visits, blood donation camp, cultural activities, NSS camps, and more. Members reviewed the draft and provided feedback and suggestions for improvement. It was decided to finalize the calendar after incorporating these suggestions and receiving additional input from faculty members, after which it will be circulated to all faculty and students for their reference.

Item No. 3: Strategic Plan for the Session 2024-25

In the discussion regarding the strategic plan for the session 2024-25, several key initiatives were outlined to enhance the overall growth and development of the college. The house was informed that the process for obtaining the of temporary extension of affiliation for BBA-3rd year (2nd Unit) and BCA-2nd year (One Unit) has already been initiated. Strengthening of the SAVJC Alumni Association and increased participation and engagement of alumni were













This progression reflects the institution's commitment to equipping students with industry-relevant expertise for professional growth.

Item No. 3: To organize Finishing School Programme at the end of the semester

A comprehensive Finishing School Programme is planned to be conducted during the second week of February 2025, specifically designed for final-year students. The primary objective of this initiative is to equip students with the essential skills and knowledge needed to enhance their employability and ensure a smooth transition from academics to the professional world.

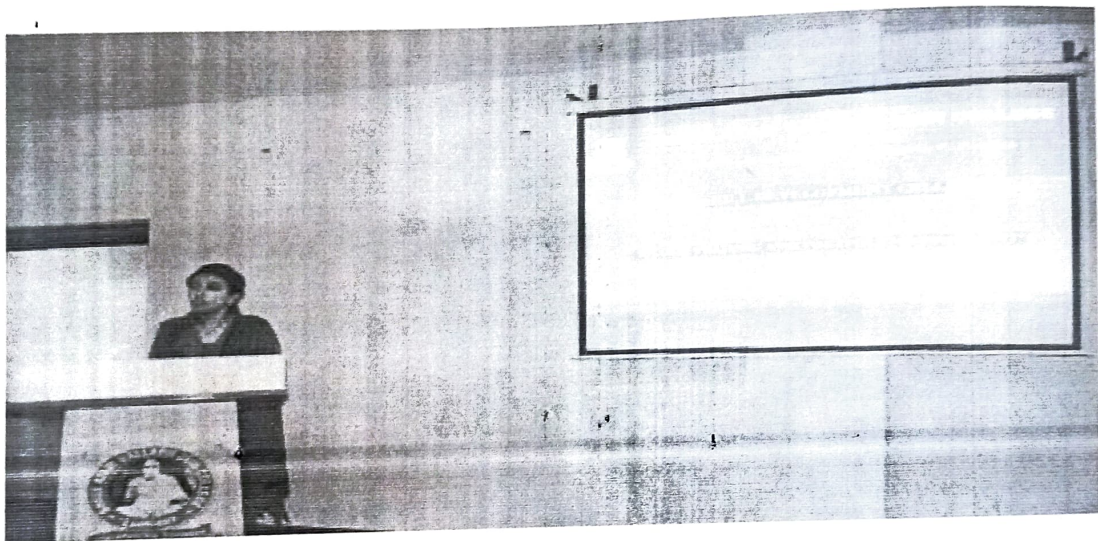
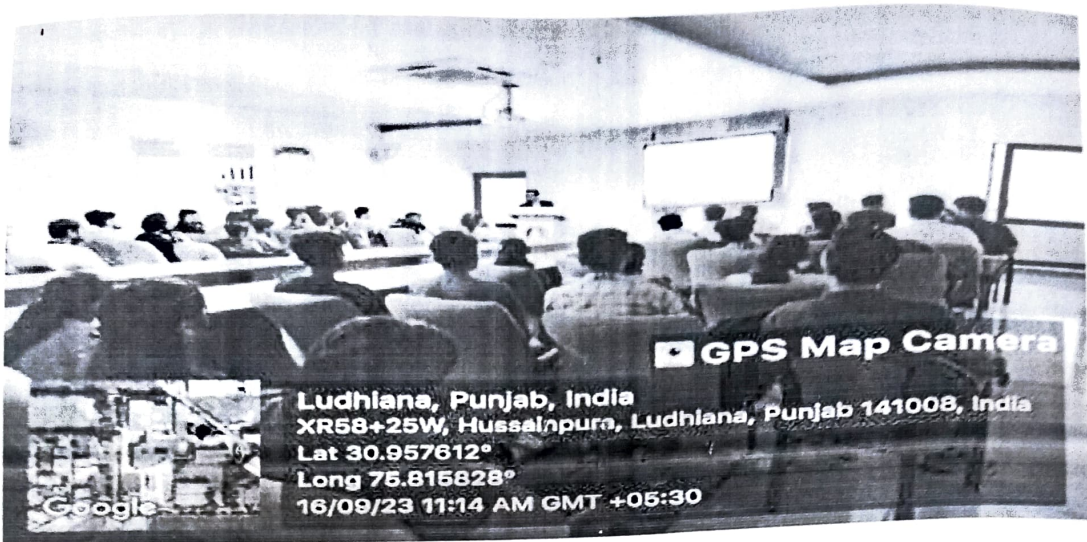
2. To promote financial literacy and awareness among participants, enabling them to navigate the complexities of the stock market confidently.

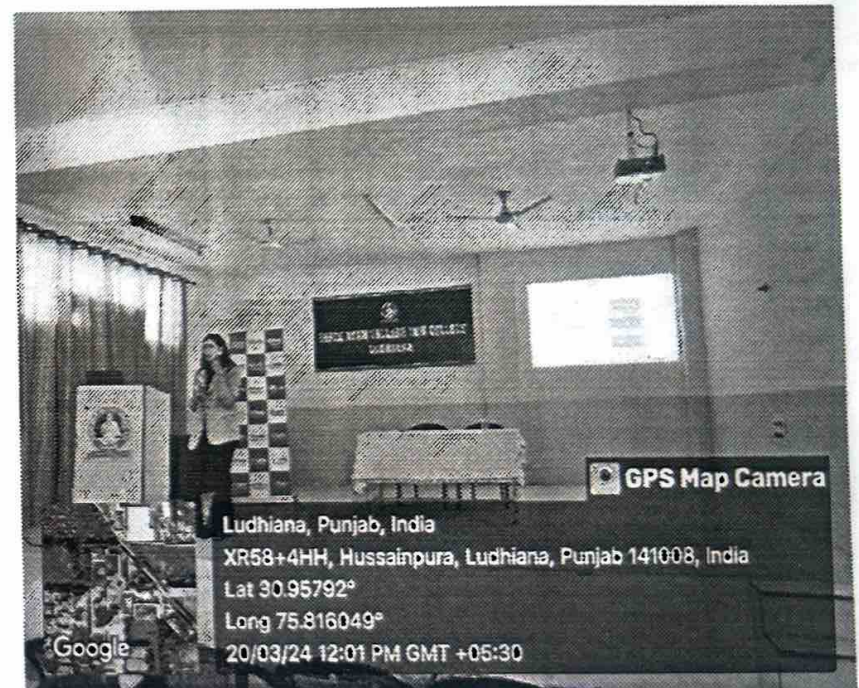
Objective of the event – To create awareness amongst students and teachers regarding healthy lifestyle choices for mental and physical well-being.

About the Event



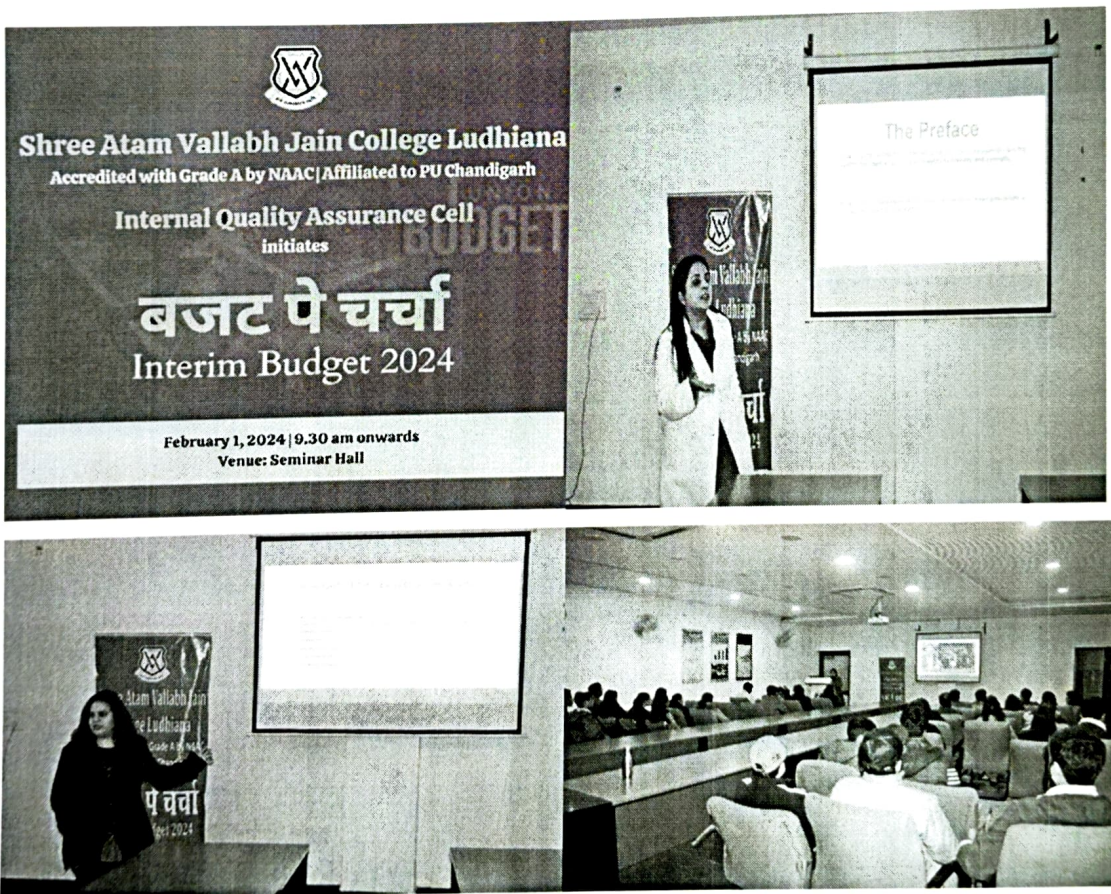

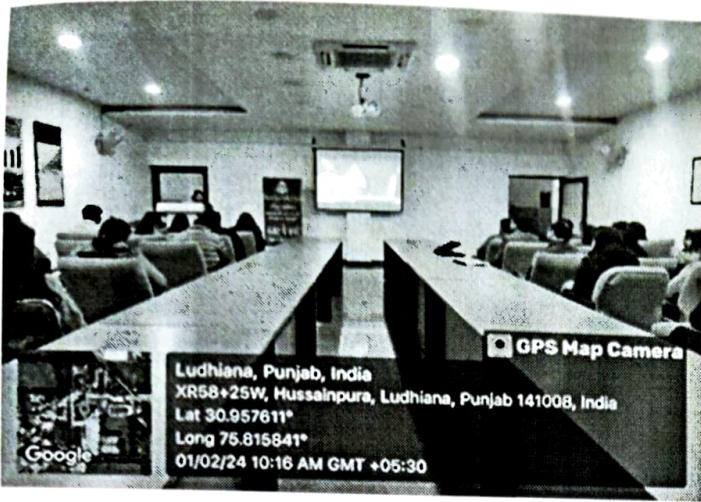
became a vibrant platform for intellectual discourse, where students and faculty members engaged in a detailed and insightful exchange of ideas and perspectives.

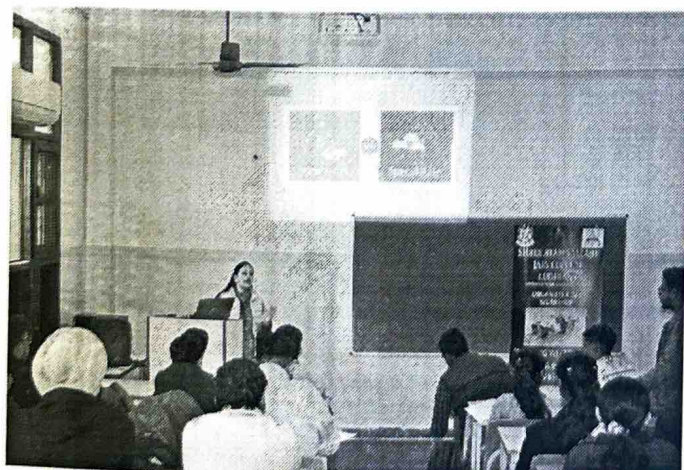
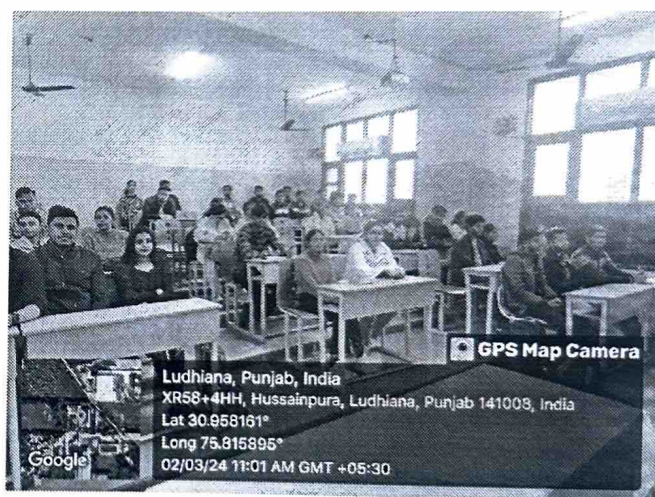
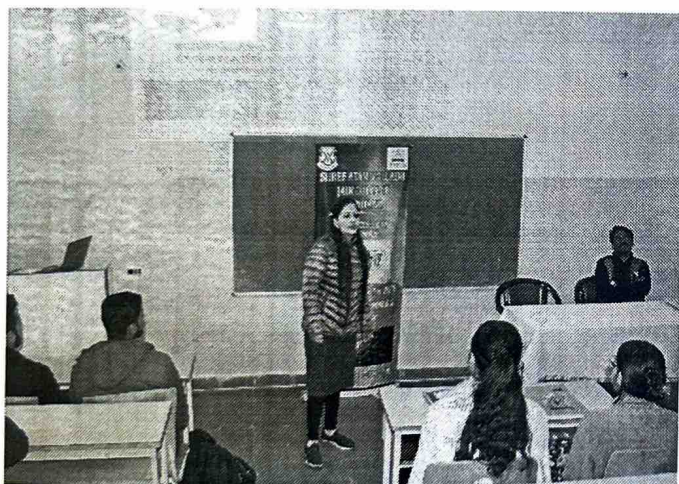
Objective of the event – To enhance the understanding of students regarding basics of stock market investing.

About the Event

Shree Atam Vallabh Jain College organized a five-day workshop titled "Building Wealth with Stocks: A Beginner's Workshop." Dr. Kiranpreet Kaur led the first session, providing practical guidance on various basics of stock market investing. Beginning with the essentials, students learned about investment options, the power of compounding, and the distinction between primary and secondary markets. The session also covered essential knowledge about different indices, both domestic and global, and elucidated the process of opening a demat account, a prerequisite for trading in the stock market. Moreover, students were instructed on the procedures involved in buying and selling stocks, laying the groundwork for understanding market operations. By the end of the session, participants gained a foundational understanding of stock market concepts and practical know-how, setting them on a path towards informed investment decisions.

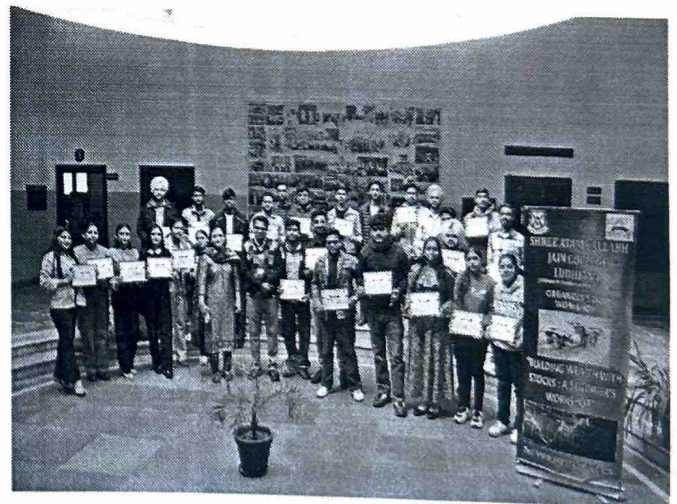
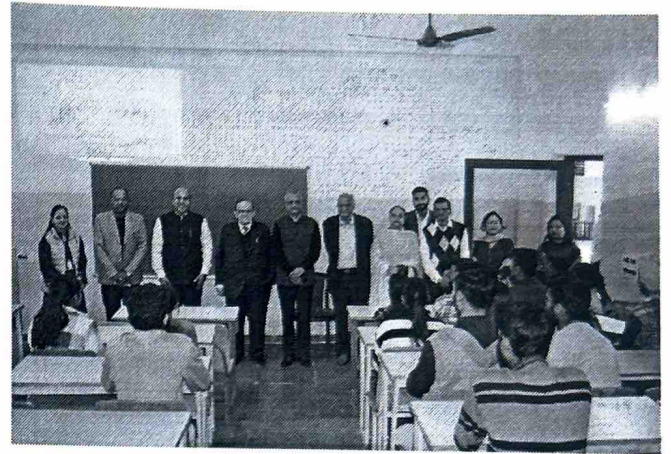
In the subsequent two sessions led by Dr. Kiranpreet Kaur, the focus shifted to fundamental analysis in stock market investing. Students were guided through the essentials of stock analysis, covering topics such as company selection criteria, PE ratio, price to book value ratio, beta factor of stocks, bid-ask spreads, debt equity ratio, ROE, ROCE, past sales and profit trends, and the analysis of annual reports, among other fundamental factors. Through practical demonstrations, students were shown how to apply these analytical tools to evaluate the performance and financial health of companies. Real-world examples were utilized to illustrate the application of these concepts, enhancing students' understanding and proficiency in fundamental analysis. By the end of these sessions, students had acquired valuable skills and knowledge to assess investment opportunities more effectively in the stock market.

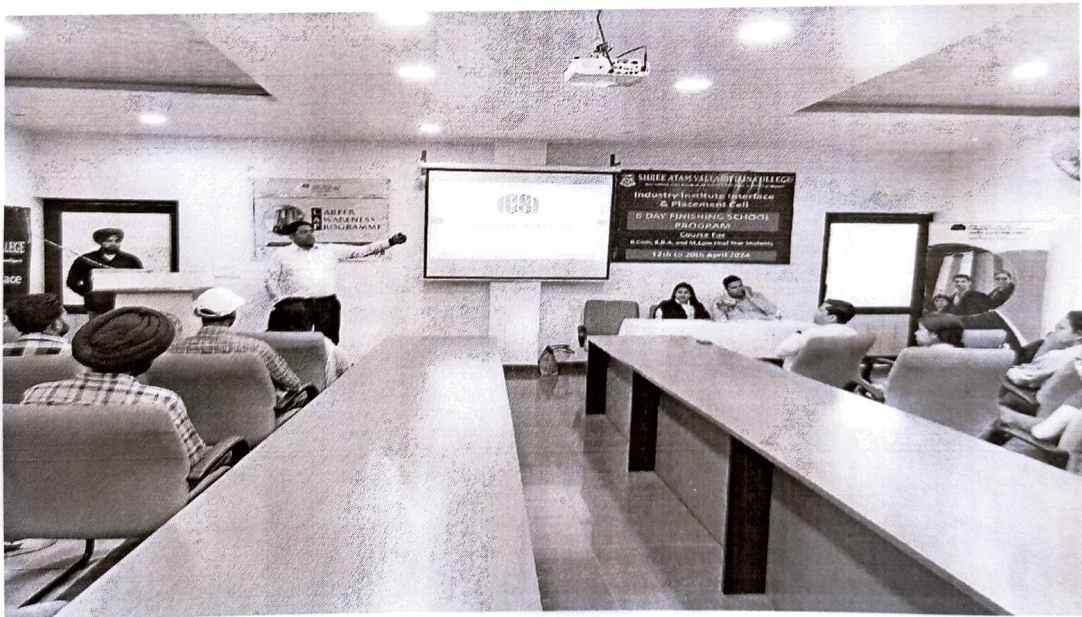
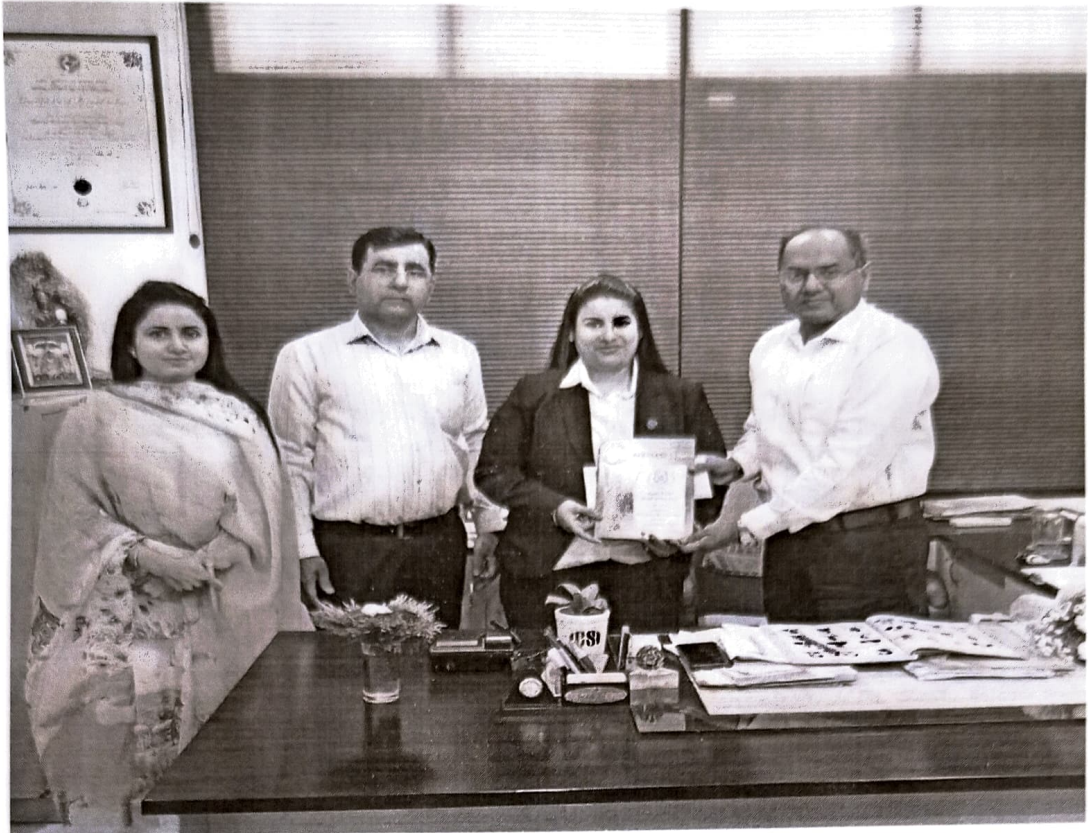
Brief description about the event

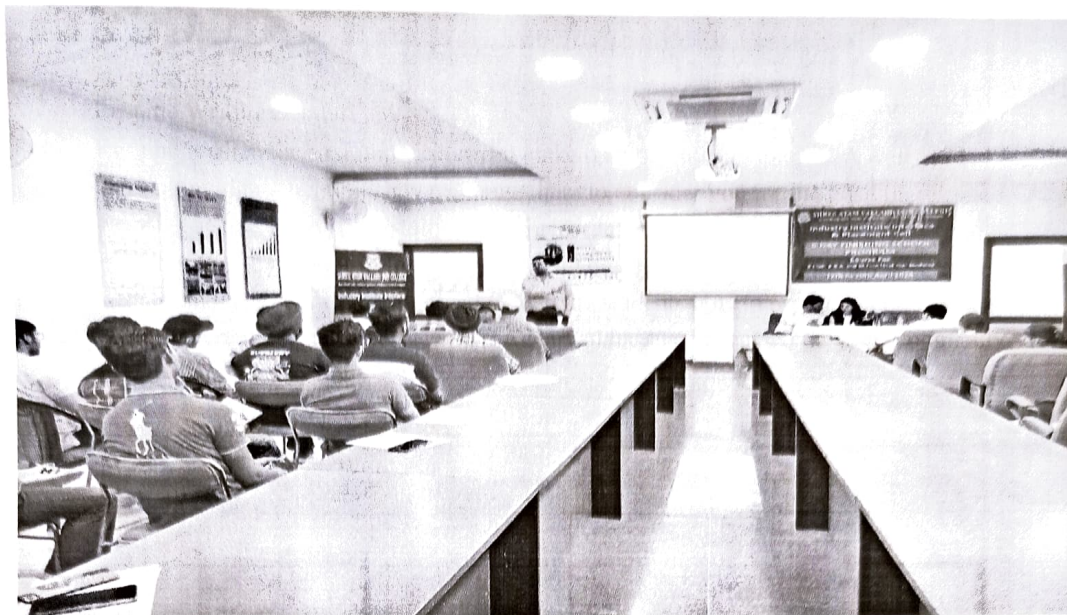

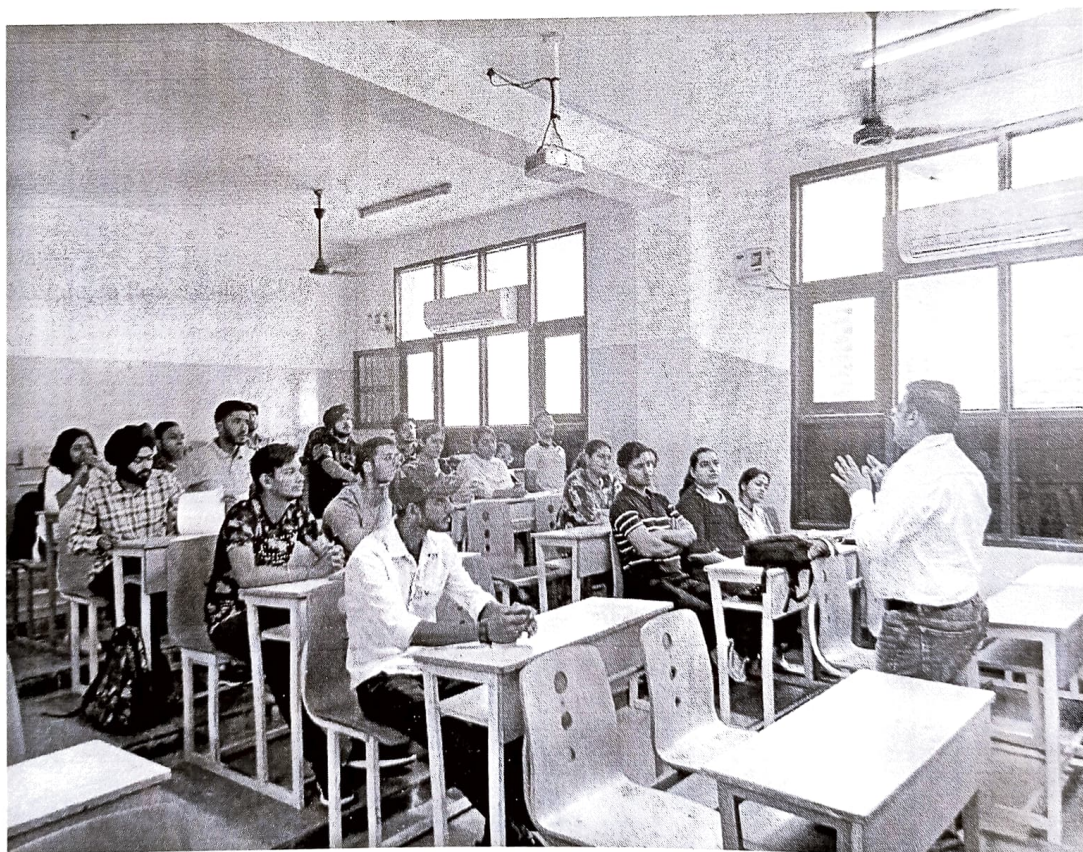
Financial Awareness

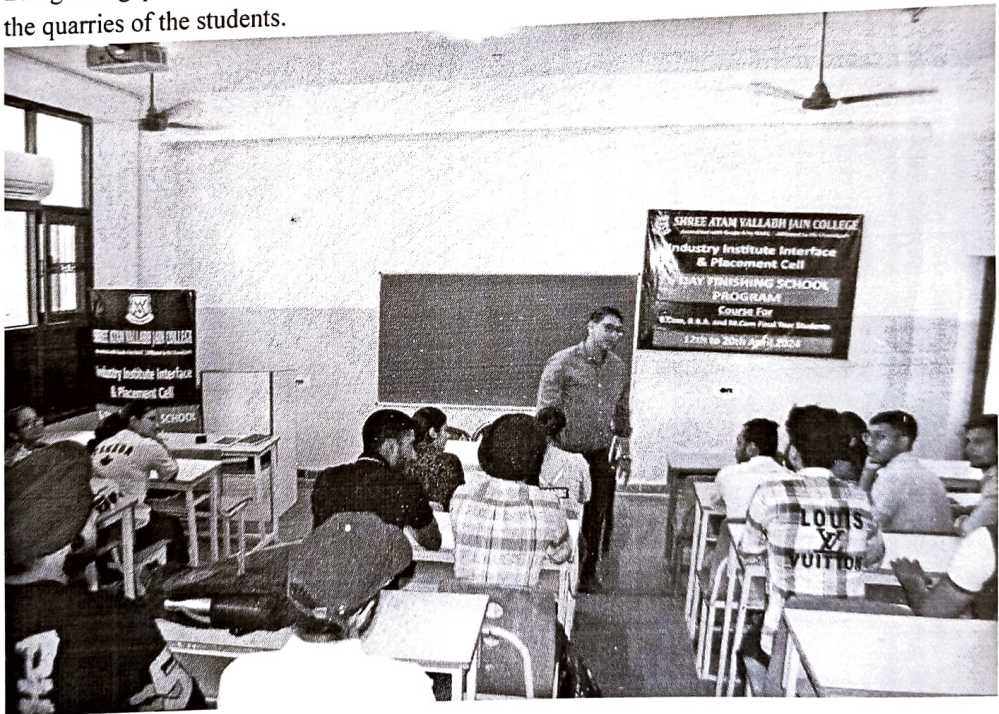

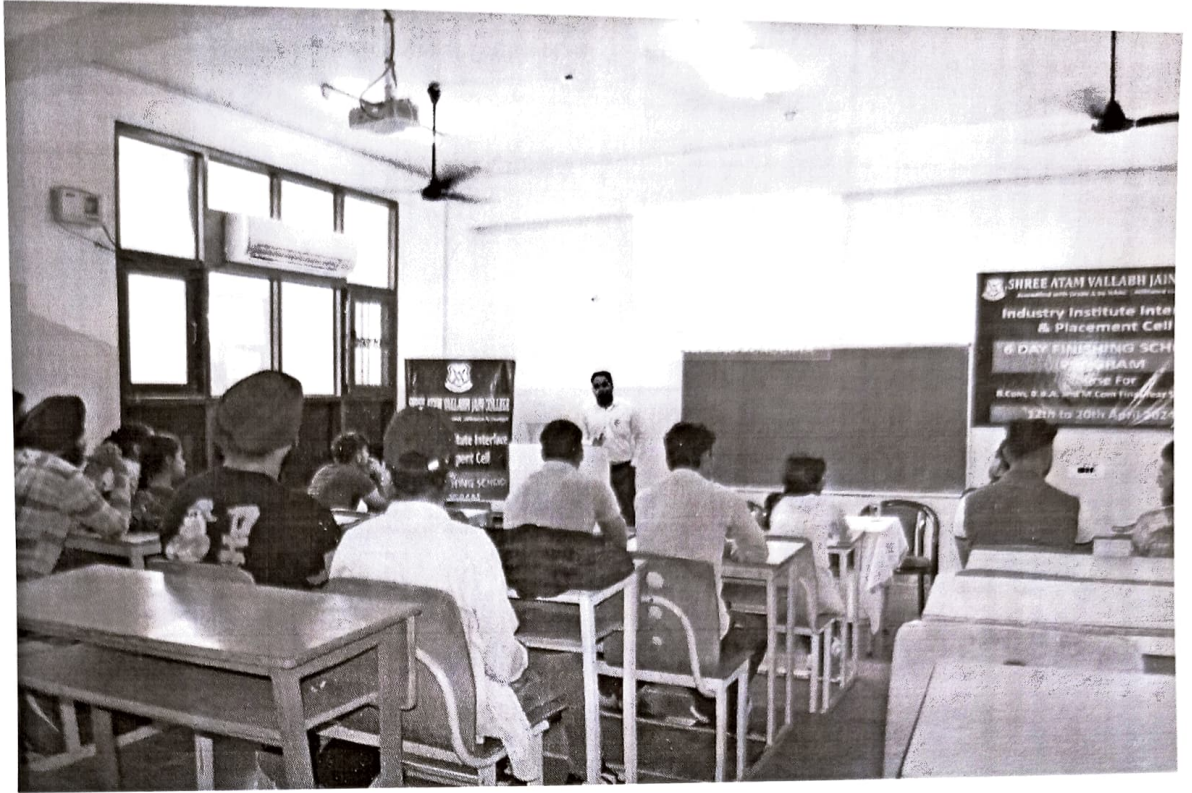
Mock Interviews

The course aimed to nurture students of B.Com I, II, III and B.BA I, II, III in order to provide them opportunity to enhance their skills and knowledge.

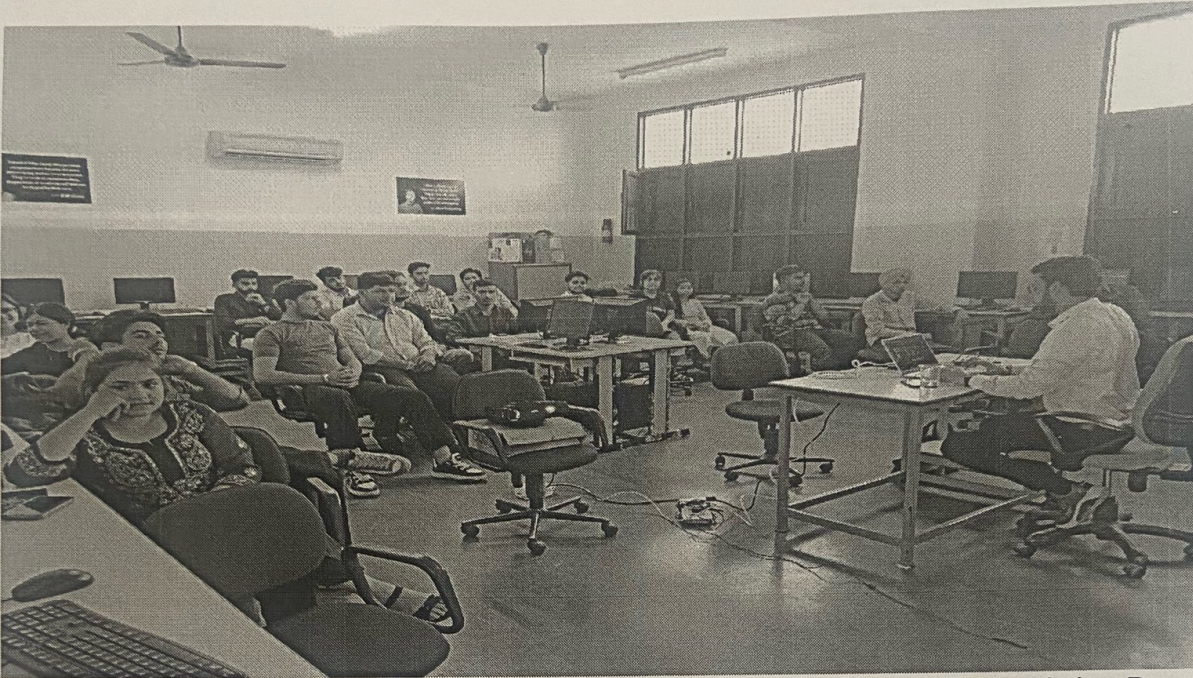
