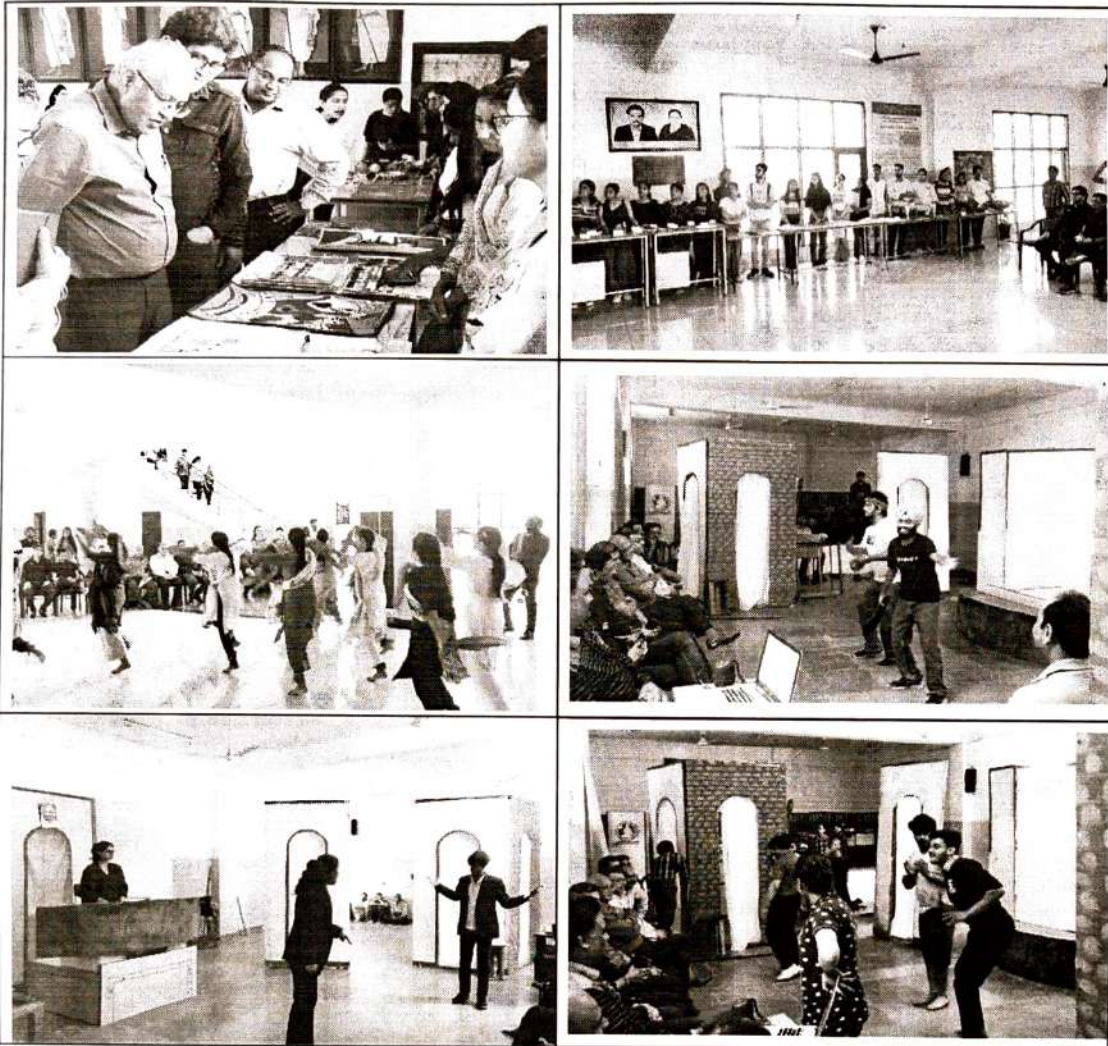
Objective of the Event: To select the participants for Youth Festivals and various other Inter College/University Competitions

rejuvenating meditation to enhance their personal well being. This holistic approach encapsulated the essence of NSS values-learning, service and personal well being.





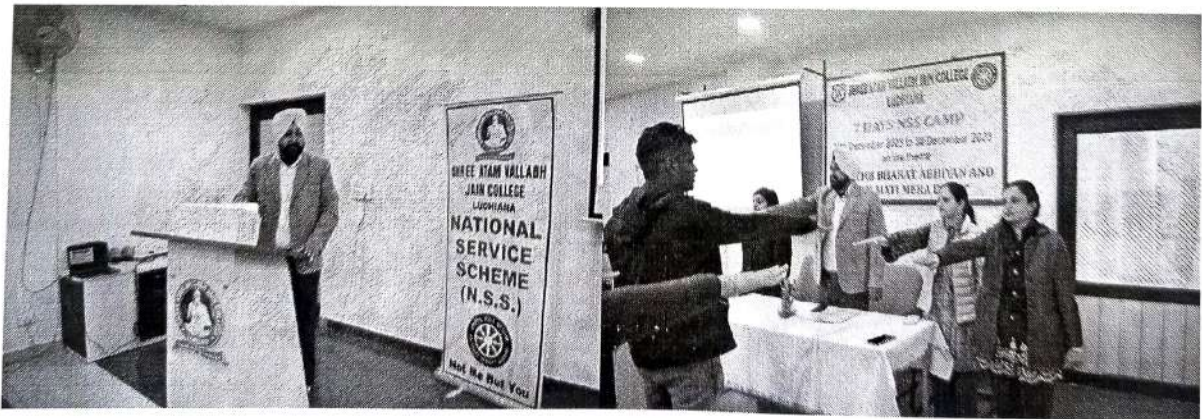
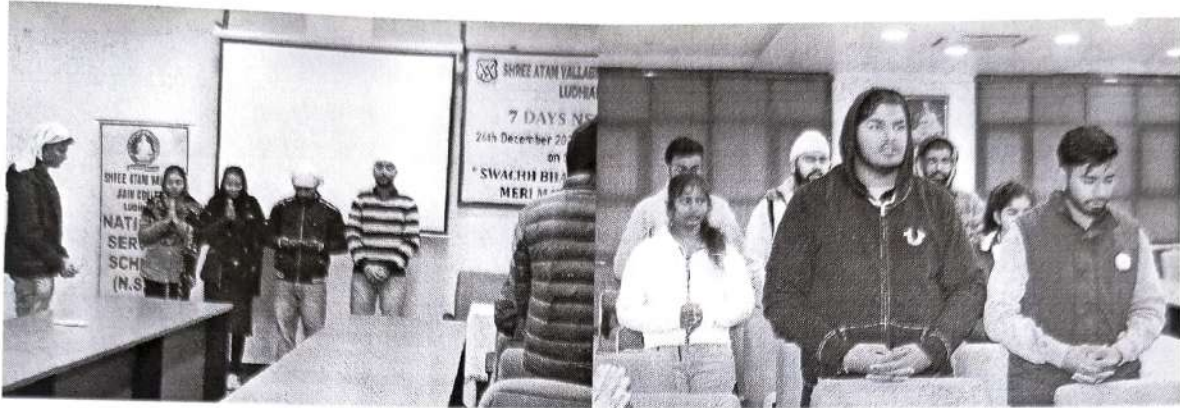

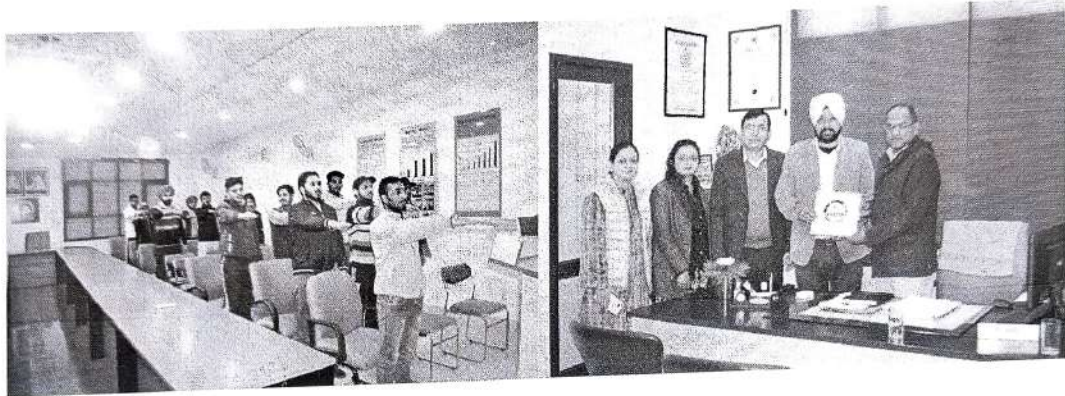
Lecture by S. Davinder Singh Lottey, Assistant Director, Youth Services, Punjab

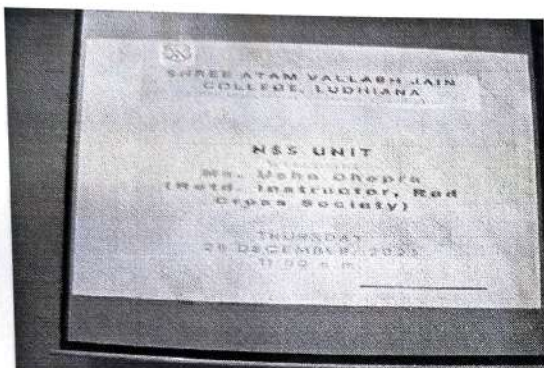

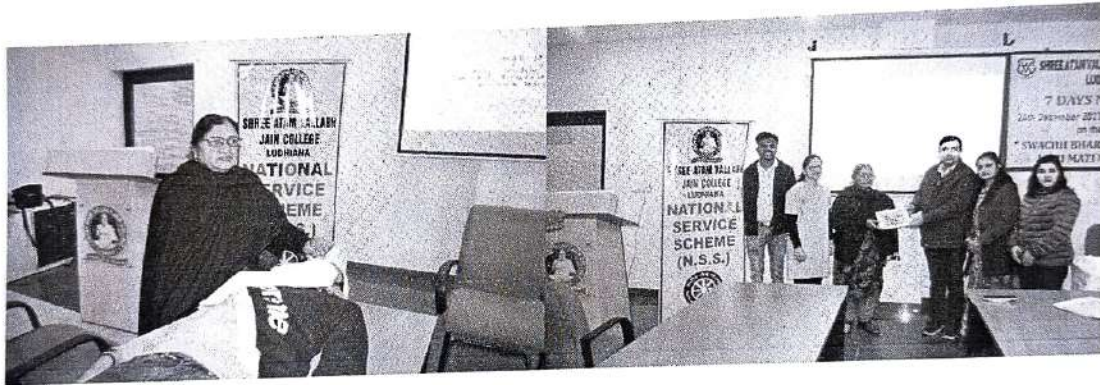
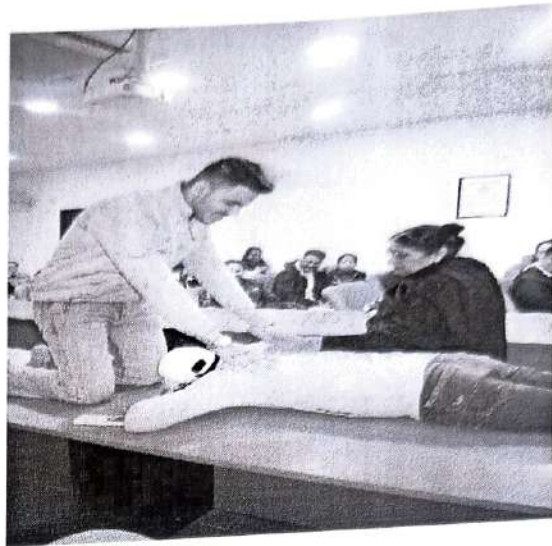
Training session on First Aid

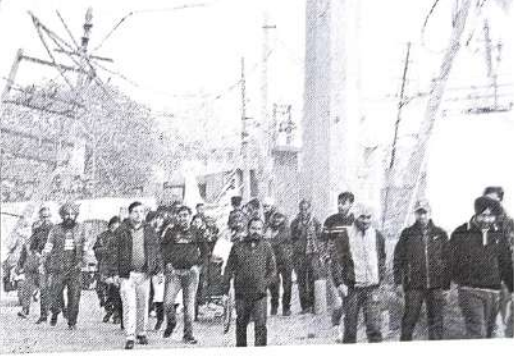
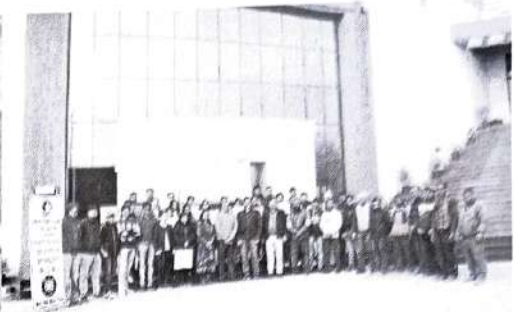

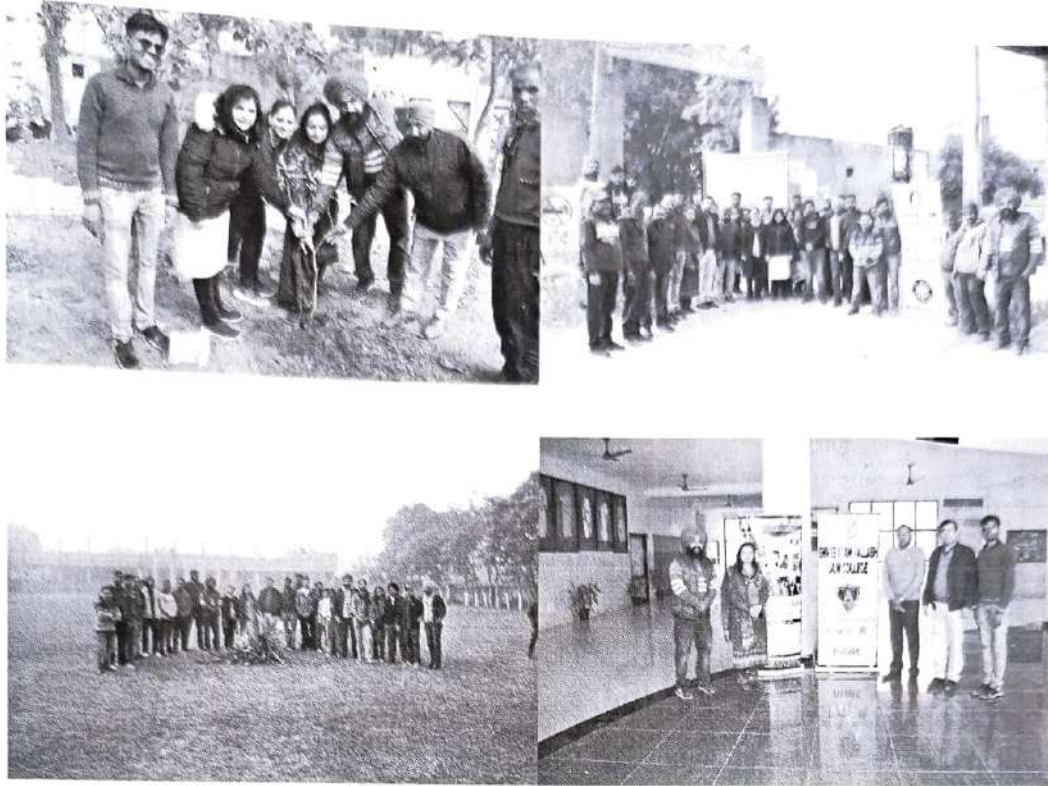
Awareness Rally to Village

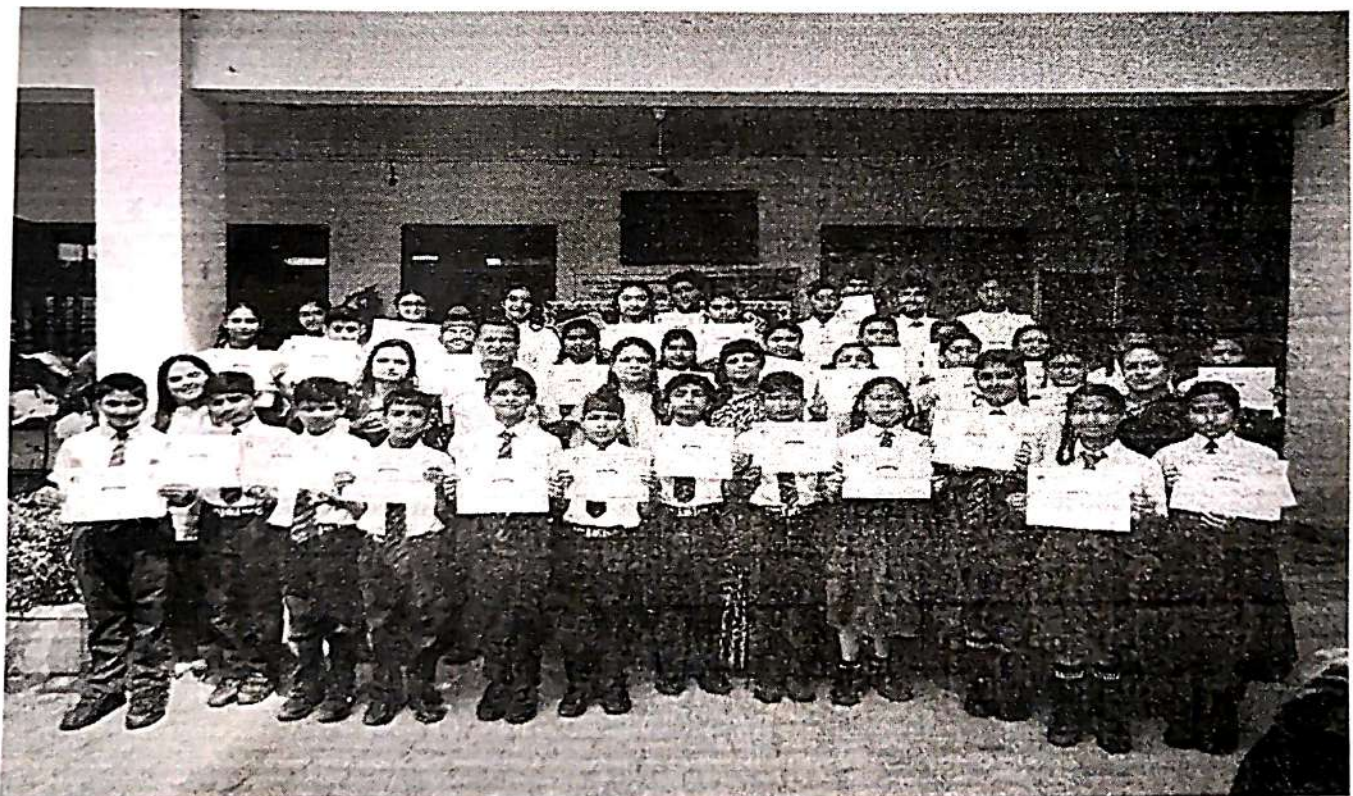

Schoolchildren practice *asanas* virtually

Tomorrow is the International Yoga Day and adhering to directives from the Union Government, thousands of students from both government and private schools observe it. However, this time around, the state administration has requested that teachers and students at government schools celebrate the day virtually because of the extreme heatwave conditions.
